

# HUC Officers Meeting Minutes

- **Action Items from last meeting**
  - Melvin to talk to UH about megaphone and coolers **(Done)**
  - Melvin to check out HUC storage unit for Summer Hat supplies **(Done)**
  - Melvin to determine plan for taking supplies from the UH Fields **(Done)**
  - Melvin to look into prizes for Disc Olympics **(Done)**
  - Brad Funk, Aaron Damm, and Eric Strom to discuss budget for Summer Hat Dinner **(Done)**
  - Asif, Brooks, Melvin to talk about allowing those playing in the fall series a spot in CSS **(Done)**
  - Greg Lopp to check out how to differentiate prices for students and non-students on the website **(Done)**
  
- **Winter League** (Thomas Jackson)
  - Want to reward person to design disc
    - Come out of HUC budget
    - <http://fiveultimate.com/store/bags/black-player-bag-2.html>
  - Want to run differently this year
    - late signups will not be allowed due to difficulty of switching around players
    - Should we allow subs for each week?
      - Austin lets people play if available from week to week
    - Had enough people for 10 teams last year, but weren't prepared for it
    - Need to make incentives for early signups to deter late signups
    - Put out all the information early and don't let late signups
    - 
    - Possibly accumulate critical mass of late signups and make a 2nd draft
    - It's easier to go from 10 to 8 teams than accommodating the growth on draft day
  - Eric : Issue with two captains for each team
    - Can create uneven teams due to better captains teammates
    - Cap the rank of 1st round picks if the captains' rank are too high
  - Mary : willing to conduct co-ed event
  - Kickoff party didn't get a lot of attendance last year
  - Need a theme
  - **ACTION : Need shirt count for Winter League (David Brooks)**
  - **ACTION : Need inventory for other items (David Brooks)**
  - **ACTION : Talk to Kim at UH to reserve the fields (Melvin Wang)**
  
- Increasing the number of women at events (Cat Shirvel)
  - There aren't enough women to spread over 10 teams for Winter League
  - It would be helpful to have a clinic two weeks before league
    - Possibly offer buddy discount for event
  - Three women per team for league is not good enough
    - had 37 women last year for eight teams
  - Get thoughts for women playing in current CSS cycle how they thought about a co-ed game or open game
    - Asif : would love feedback
    - **ACTION : Give Cat names of women playing current CSS cycle (Greg Lopp)**
  - Good men play in open division leaving lower players for co-ed

- If you sign up for a co-ed league you can't be upset about the co-ed division
- Newbie fee for winter league to encourage newer players
- We need more beginner friendly events and more women events
  - Ran skills and drills before winter league two years ago
  - Going to need help to organize all this
  - Would love to have fall league for women
    - Need lit fields, signups cannot sustain it
    - HUC will need to fund the fields
- Down the road we might want to think about open and women's leagues
- Black Angus can run clinics before winter league
  - About 4 clinics
  - Maybe run events on Thurs night or before winter league
  - **ACTION : Come up for ideas for clinics during winter league (Cat)**
- **CSS/CIS**
  - Last cycle for CSS
    - Melvin did a lot to get good numbers for signups
  - CIS
    - Kicks is acting like nothing happened last year
    - The rate is less than last year, but still high
    - Second option for indoor
      - Ceiling is low, lighting is bad
      - Should be fourth of the price of kicks
      - Willing to play for pickup game to check it out
    - **ACTION : TJ and Asif to discuss second option for CIS by Sept 15th**
  - Looking to have pickup between CSS and CIS
- **Hat Tournament (Melvin Wang)**
  - Registration : \$2665.00
  - Expenses : \$842.22
  - Profit : \$1807.00 (collected)
  - Issue with registration
  - Need to have more people dedicated for registration
    - More accountability for people showing up and collecting money
    - Try running registration with a laptop
  - There were issues with not enough women
  - Need to get the captains involved with payment
  - Split is 75/25 for UH/HUC
- **Treasurer's report (Eric Strom)**
  - Participants need to see someone for a packet and payment
  - Don't allow people to play past 3rd week without payment
  - Money needs to be due first day
  - Event Coordinator (or delegate) needs to track down payment, not treasurer
  - Try having a registration number
    - Used for check in and team assignments
    - Allows tracking of payments
- Storage Facility
  - **ACTION : Return all summer hat items to storage (Melvin Wang)**
  - Asif has the port-a-field
  - Items need to be returned before next event starts

- New promotional magnet for HUC
