

HUC Leadership Positions:

Board of Directors: Like any other organizations, the Board of Directors is not an elected position. Board Members will strive to provide strategic guidance to the Houston Ultimate Community, by-laws, and the IRS Tax Filings. Because this is a pivotal strategic role, board members need to be willing to serve a 2-year term. The determination of the members of the Board of Directors will come from the input of the newly-elected officers (see below) and the final decision from the existing Board of Directors.

President: The role of the President is to provide strategic guidance on PR and membership, and assist at a high level with the organization of events. Additionally, the President will fill in the gaps with event oversight and assist in organizing volunteers for any help needed in order to make events successful. Ideally, this position will be a 2-year commitment.

Treasurer: The role of the Treasurer is being expanded to approve budgets for events, approve reimbursements and write checks, as well as to post finances to the website. This person must be detail-oriented and work with each Event Officer to ensure event success.

Webmaster: The webmaster is responsible for look/feel on the web, content, event sign-ups, polls, forums, etc. More than one webmaster is welcome (and greatly appreciated!), but HUC needs one person to be accountable for the website maintenance at the end of the day (ie, making sure the code is not broken, ensuring up-time especially around events, etc.) This person must be easily accessible via phone or e-mail to help troubleshoot any problems, especially around event milestones (sign up deadlines, day before events, etc.) We are also looking for an **apprentice** to the current webmaster to assist in the website development while learning the tricks of the trade.

Community Relations: This officer will be responsible for establishing relationships with businesses and organizations for the purpose of providing monetary or product support for HUC events. This person will secure this support in conjunction with the event coordinators so that the event can provide a bigger draw for participants and/or greater contribution to the charity chosen for that event. They will be responsible for communicating contacts and progress updates to the HUC officers and can solicit assistance from community members. They will be responsible for establishing relationships with Houston-area non-profit, charitable organizations for the purpose of linking HUC events to specific charities. This person will bridge the gap between each HUC event coordinator and the event-specific charity contact. The liaison will report all charitable details directly to both the event coordinator and the president.

Youth Director: This officer will be responsible for increasing youth playing opportunities (clinics, leagues, tournaments, etc.), widening awareness of our sport to the youth (middle, high school and some college) in the Houston community, and enhancing the current HUC events with respect to development of youth.

Women's Director: This officer will take on the task of increasing women's playing opportunities (clinics, leagues, tournaments, etc.), widening awareness of our sport to the women in the Houston community, and enhancing the current HUC events with respect to women.

Secretary: This officer will be responsible for taking minutes during the officers' meetings, assisting with the histories of events, and creating content for the HUC website.

Event Officers: Event Officers are responsible for the specific event. The HUC Board will assist with historical knowledge, budget information, lessons learned, and will help recruit additional volunteers. *Local Teams and other groups are welcome to sign up to run an event; in return, a percentage of the proceeds will go back to the team to continue to build the community.
